James Norton died on Sunday at his residence at Wyckoff's Mills [NJ], aged 69 years. Death was caused by tuberculosis of the liver after a protracted illness. Mr. Norton was a son of the late Richard Norton and a brother of Wm. R., Joshua R. and Charles M. Norton, of this place. He leaves a widow, who was formerly Miss Ada R. Carnahan, well known as a writer and a niece of Alice and Phoebe Cary. Mr. Norton moved from this vicinity to Farmer Village, N.Y., a number of years ago, and resided there until last year when he bought the Wyckoff's Mills, which he has since operated. Mr. Norton was well known and highly esteemed in this section as a man of strict integrity and unblemished character. He had many friends and in his death the community loses a prominent and valuable member.
