Mrs. Martin S. Norton passed away at her home in Detroit, Mich., Wednesday, Jan. 19, after an illness of a little more than a week, from the effects of acute spinal meningitis. The remains were brought here on train 26 Friday and taken to the home of Mrs. Gardner Wells, where the funeral was held Saturday afternoon at 2:30, conducted by Rev. M. L. Hadley, pastor of the Universalist church. There was a large attendance of sympathizing friends and many beautiful flowers attested the esteem in which she was held. Burial was at Mt. Hope.

Nora Wells Norton, the only child of Gardner and Emily Wells, was born in the town of Friendship October 2, 1866. In 1890 she was married to Martin Norton, one son, Frank Norton, blessing their union. Some ten years ago they left Friendship for Virginia, where they remained for a time, going from there to Locke, N.Y., and later onto Detroit, where they have lived five years.
