MACEDON.

The death of Mrs. Rachel Clute Noxon occurred at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Emma Lapham, Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Mrs. Noxon was 83 years of age, having been born at Vischers Ferry, Saratoga county, August 15, 1838. In 1857 she was married to George Noxon, the couple shortly after moving to Macedon. In 1894 the family removed to Rochester, where they resided until 1918, when Mr. and Mrs. Noxon again took up their residence in Macedon. Mr. Noxon died the same year. Mrs. Noxon continued in good health until a few days ago when bronchial pneumonia developed from a slight cold. She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Emma Lapham and Miss Katherine Noxon, of Macedon; a son, Clute E. Noxon, of Rochester; one granddaughter, Mrs. Frederick [Katherine] Kemp, of Macedon; a sister, Mrs. Marie Furman, of Schenectady, and one brother, James Clute, of Ballston Spa, N.Y. The funeral was held from her late home Thursday, Rev. A. [Adelbert] E. Allison of the Universalist church officiating.
