DEATH CLAIMS GEORGE NOYES Well Known Resident of Salisbury Center Passes Away

DOLGEVILLE—Having suffered a stroke of paralysis about ten days ago, death came to George E. Noyes, Sr., a well known resident of Salisbury Center at his home there Monday.
