JOSEPH H. NUTTING

The death of Joseph H. Nutting of Watertown occurred on May 1 following a year of declining health. He was born in Dexter on November 20, 1869, and located in Watertown in his eighteenth year. He became one of the best known book-keepers in the city. In later years he was employed by the Agricultural Insurance Company. He was a member of All Souls church and for more than twenty years served as a deacon. He was also prominent in Masonic circles. He is survived by his widow [Elizabeth], a daughter-in-law, two grandchildren and two cousins. Dr. Harold H. Niles, pastor, conducted the funeral service on May 3.
