Mrs. Frances Rebecca Nye, wife of Ira Nye of Alexander[,] died Monday night at her home in that village after a forty-eight hours' illness with bronchial pneumonia.

Five years ago she suffered a severe shock of paralysis [a stroke] and had been in feeble health since that time.

Mrs. Nye was 77 years of age, having been born April 29, 1839. She was a daughter of Zena and Rebecca Waite of Darien and resided there until her marriage to Ira Nye December 14, 1864. She had resided in Michigan and was a resident of Corfu for fifteen years, locating in Alexander five years ago. Besides her husband she leaves one son Carl and a sister, Mrs. H. L. Sherrick of Ionia, Mich.

Funeral services were held at 12 o'clock today at the family home and burial took place in Corfu.
