MAURICE C. OSTERHOUDT

Maurice C. Osterhoudt, 86, of West Oneonta, died Wednesday, May 17, at Woodside Hall in Cooperstown following an extended illness.

Mr. Osterhoudt was born on September 24, 1885 in the Town of Oneonta, son of Abram and Phoebe (VanBuren) Osterhoudt.

He married Catherine Hopkins June 22, 1916 at the Universalist parsonage in Cooperstown.
