Elmer E. Ottman

The Little Falls Times last evening published the following: "Elmer E. Ottman, for twelve years a respected resident of this city, died at his home in Jackson street yesterday morning of consumption, of which he had long been a sufferer. Mr. Ottman was born in Fonda April 21, 1863, his parents being Mr. and Mrs. Hiram Ottman. The family resided in Fort Plain for a number of years. Since coming to Little Falls Mr. Ottman was employed in various knitting mills up to two years ago, when failing health compelled him to relinquish all work. Fifteen years ago he was married to Lettie Phillips of Fort Plain, who survives, also his father, Hiram Ottman of this city, and five brothers, Charles of Schenectady, Lester of Gloversville, Harry of Herkimer, and Frank and George of this city, and four sisters, Mrs. William Van Slyke of Mindenville, Mrs. Jay Brown of Fonda, and Ethel and Susie Ottman of this city. The funeral will be held from the Universalist church, of which deceased was an active and worthy member, tomorrow at 1 o'clock, Revs. Benton and Conrad officiating. Interment will be made at Fort Plain.
