Mrs. Florence Padelford, widow of the late Captain Harvey Padelford, died at the Health Home in Canandaigua on Wednesday, January 28th, at the age of 67 years. She had been ill since New Year's Day. Mrs. Padelford was formerly Miss Florence Doubleday of Victor. Her girlhood was passed east of this village on her father's farm, the place now occupied by Durfee Randall. In recent years she frequently visited here and was well known by many Victor people.

The surviving relatives are a sister, Mrs. A. H. [Ruth] Padelford; a nephew, Harvey Padelford, both of Canandaigua; and three cousins, Mrs. R. B. True of Syracuse, Janes H. Smith and David C. Smith, both of Brownsville, Wash.

Funeral services will be held at Kennedy's undertaking rooms in Canandaigua at 2 o'clock on Saturday afternoon. Burial will be made in the south Farmington meeting house cemetery.
