CLARENDON

Mrs. Adelia M. Palmer died at her home on the 18th inst. and was buried in Holley the 20th. The funeral was held at the Universalist church, Rev. H. A. Markley officiating. Mrs. Palmer was born in Cambridge, Washington county, N.Y., in 1809, and moved to Clarendon in 1818, where she has since resided. Mrs. Palmer died just two years to a day after the death of her daughter, Mrs. M. D. [Olivia] Snyder, and also on the wedding anniversary of her son, A. C. Frederick, and that of her granddaughter, Mrs. Mina Holt. Mrs. Palmer drew a widow's pension from the war of 1812. She was an estimable woman, and when sickness came to neighbors and friends she was always to be depended upon and was indeed "a friend in need." She leaves a son and two daughters, A. C. Frederick of Clarendon, Mary E. Mower of Hartland, and Helen M. Whitney of Cleveland, Ohio.
