Death's Summons Comes to John. H. Pardee

Feb. 22.—The death of John H. Pardee occurred at the home of his son, Thomas Pardee, in this village, Thursday evening, after an illness of but a few days. He was aged 75 years. Deceased was a native of Cheshire, Conn. In 1880 he came to Fort Plain and accepted a position as foreman in one of the departments of the Fort Plain Spring and Axle company's plant, a position he held with satisfaction to his employers until a short time previous to the company's removal to Chicago Heights, when he accepted a position in Dunkirk. For the past two years he has resided with his son Thomas. He is survived by his widow, an invalid, and by one son. The funeral will be held at his home Sunday at 2 p.m., the Rev. L. [Louis] J. Richards officiating. Interment will be made in Fort Plain.
