F. E. PARKER DIES IN HOME

Fred E. Parker, 30 Greenwood Ct., died unexpectedly last night in his home of a heart ailment.

Mr. Parker was born in Utica 75 years ago, the son of the late John and Catherine Pepper Parker of Manchester, England. His entire life was spent in Utica, where he attended local schools and in 1900 married the late Alene Quinn Parker. For 57 years he was associated with A. S. Cook, wholesale furniture dealers, Medina. He was a member of the Universalist Church.

He leaves two daughters, Mrs. Emmon Raymonds, St. Albans, and Mrs. Milo Nichols, Utica; one son, R. E. Parker, Utica, and five grandchildren.
