DEATH OF JAMES PARRISH

James Parrish, who had been a resident of Auburn for something like forty years, died at his residence on McMaster street at seven o'clock Friday. Mr. Parrish was born in Dutchess county nearly eighty-six years ago, and came to Auburn to enter Barber's factory, where he followed his trade as a dyer until failing health compelled him to relinquish his work. He married a sister of the late Josiah Barber, and his wife and three out of five children survive him. Of the living children, Lucius C. Parrish lives in Boston, while another son, Elbert R., and a daughter live at the old home in this city. Mr. Parrish was a genial neighbor and associate and will be mourned by many friends. He was a Universalist in faith and regularly attended the church of that denomination.
