MRS. ALBERT O. PARSHALL

The death of Mrs. Albert O. Parshall occurred at her home at Whig Corners, Sunday, April 20th, as the result of a general breakdown of health which began several months ago, since which time she has gradually weakened. Mrs. Parshall was eighty-four years old. She was born in the town of Westford and was the daughter of Bela J. and Maria Bailey Kaple. Her marriage to Albert O. Parshall occurred October 26, 1858, since which [time] they have lived continuously at Whig Corners. This record of more than sixty years of married life is a notable one and is seldom equalled. [sic] Mrs. Parshall laid down the burden of life after long and satisfying service as wife, mother, home-maker and useful member of the community.

She is survived by her husband, two sons, Fred Parshall of Plattsburg, Bert Parshall and a daughter, Mrs. Howard Clark, both of Whig Corners, and one brother, L. A. Kaple of Cooperstown. The funeral was held at her late home Tuesday afternoon, the Rev. Charles Kramer of the Universalist church officiating. Interment in Lakewood cemetery.
