MRS. JOHN PEASE DIES

Mrs. Esther Close Pease, wife of John Pease, died suddenly this morning at her home in East Cayuga Street, Moravia, after suffering a heart attack. She was 79 years old.

Mrs. Pease was born in Conesus, N. Y., on April 24, 1850, a daughter of Rastus and Matilda Tallman Close. Most of her life was spent in Scipio. She had resided in Moravia the past seven years. Mrs. Pease was a member of the Universalist Church at Scipio.

Surviving are her husband; one son, Clare Pease of New York City; a daughter, Mrs. Willard Coulson of Scipio; two grandchildren and one brother, Eugene Close of Moravia.

The funeral will be held at 2 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the home. Rev. W. S. Stevens, rector of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Moravia, will conduct the services. Interment will be in Indian Mound Cemetery, Moravia.
