Sheriff B. E. Peck's Funeral Thursday

WATERTOWN: The funeral for Sheriff Brayton E. Peck, 71, who died suddenly Tuesday morning in the sheriff's apartments at the county jail, will be Thursday (today) at 2 p.m. at the sheriff's residence. Rev. Dr. Harold H. Niles, pastor of All Souls Universalist church, will officiate. Burial will be made in the Dexter cemetery.

Mr. Peck, sheriff of Jefferson County for nearly 20 years, had been in poor health for years. Death was caused by a heart attack. Sheriff Peck was also president of the First National Bank of Dexter and once was supervisor of the town of Brownville.

Six deputies who worked under Sheriff Peck will be bearers. They are James H. Hagen, Albert M. Neville, Irving P. Angel, Lawrence Resome, James K. Simpson and Vernon Burrows.
