KARL O. PECK DIES AFTER LONG ILLNESS

In failing health for the past three months, Karl O. Peck, 44, insurance man and World War veteran, died in Syracuse Memorial Hospital Thursday night of general septicæmia.

A native of Syracuse, Mr. Peck was a lifelong resident of the East Side. He had been engaged in the insurance business for the past 10 years, and for the last four years was associated with the W. J. Farber Company. He was a member of the American Legion, Post 41.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Arlene Langdon Peck; a daughter, Miss Betty Tedford, 18; a son, Charles Tedford, 15, and his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George P. Peck, formerly of Syracuse, now residing in Long Beach, Calif.

Funeral services will take place at the home, 104 Euclid ter., at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon, with Rev. Ellsworth Reamon, pastor of Betts Memorial [Universalist] Church, officiating. Burial will be in Morningside cemetery.
