Leslie Peck, Dairyman, Dies at 65

Bouckville—Leslie Z. Peck, 65, died Sept. 13, 1947, in his home here after a long illness.

He was born in Pittsfield, N.Y., Nov. 27, 1881, son of George and Elizabeth Lewis Peck, and had lived here for the last 40 years.

He was division superintendent for the Muller Dairyman's League for 22 years and dairy inspector for the Muller Dairies for the last five years.

He was active in lodge work. He was a member of the Alliance Lodge, F&AM, Oriskany Falls, St. Lawrence Chapter and Commandery, Canton, and Ziyara Shrine, Utica. In the OES, he was past grand lecturer for the Cortland-Madison County District, and patron of Mayflower chapter, OES, Morrisville, for the past seven years.

He also was a member of the Board of Education of Madison Central School from its formation in 1932 to his retirement in 1945.

He was married to Myrtle Howard in 1908.

She survives, with one brother, Merton Peck, and several nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be from the home at 2 p.m. Wednesday, with Dr. Booth, former pastor of the Madison Universalist Church officiating. Mayflower chapter, OES, will conduct services. Alliance Lodge, F&AM, will be in charge of committal services in Madison Cemetery.
