Mrs. Floyd Perkins, prominent in American Legion Auxiliary activities, died Thursday in her home on Densmore Road, Town of Gaines. She was 48 years old.

Born Dec. 29, 1888 to Willis English, Rochester, and the former Mary Warner of Greece [Monroe Co. NY], Minnie Warner English Perkins had spent her life in this section. She had been in ill health for a number of years. Survivors, besides Mr. Perkins, are several cousins.

A charter member of the Albion Chapter, O.E.S., she [also] belonged to the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church and the Get Together Club of the church.

In years past Mrs. Perkins had served as president of Sheret Post Auxiliary and of Orleans County Legion Auxiliary.

The Rev. L. [Lewis] H. Robinson officiated at the funeral service Saturday afternoon in McNall's funeral home and at the grave in Mt. Albion Cemetery.
