MRS. SUSANNAH S. PERRY, 91, DIES
PASSES AWAY AT HOME OF SON IN ADAMS
TAKEN ILL EIGHT WEEKS AGO

Came to Three Mile Bay by Wagon from Otsego County When 12 Years of Age

Adams, Dec. 20.—Mrs. Susannah Smith Perry, widow of the late Joseph Henry Perry, died yesterday of abscess on the brain at the home of her son, Oscar D. perry, aged 91 years, three months and three days. She was in excellent health until eight weeks ago. Two weeks before her final illness, she visited a friend in Clay.

Mrs. Perry was born in Decatur, Otsego county, the daughter of the late John Henry and Jemima Deneur Smith. When she was 12 years of age her parents moved by wagon to Three Mile Bay, the journey taking about three days. Last summer she visited her former home there. She was one of 12 children.

Her husband died several years ago [in 1898] and she had lived with her son for the past ten years. Three children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Perry [Oscar, Eugene, and Arthur.]. Only one, the son [Oscar], survives. Besides the son she is survived by [a] sister, living in the west; one grandson, Walter Perry of Adams; three great-grandchildren, Walter, Jr., Joseph and Margaret Perry of Adams, one adopted daughter, Mrs. F. M. Bartlett of Detroit, Mich. Mrs. Bartlett came here about three weeks ago.

The funeral will be held Wednesday afternoon from the home, Rev. Harry Westbrook Reed of All Souls Universalist church, Watertown, officiating. Burial will be made at Dexter.
