BURTON PETTY RITES HELD

Burton J. Petty of Church St., Victor, died Sunday, July 21 in a Rochester hospital which he entered 17 days prior to his death. He underwent major surgery last February from which he did not fully recover. He was 81. Mr. Petty was born in Farmington, the son of Charles and Ellen Randall Petty.
