Death of Farmington Man

Charles Petty, one of the oldest residents of Farmington, died at his home in that town on Friday evening, September 30th, from a general collapse of the system. He was eighty-four years of age and had been in ill health for over a year.

Mr. Petty was born in England and when about thirty-three years old came to the United States, going directly to the town of Farmington, where he had since resided. His wife, who was formerly Miss Helen Randall of Farmington, died in August 1909. Mr. Petty leaves eight children: Charles of Pennsylvania, William of Shortsville, Edward of Shortsville, Frank of Rochester, Albert of Farmington, Mrs. Fred [Mary] Broomfield of Farmington, Miss Jenny Petty of Rochester, Miss Sarah Petty of Farmington; and eight grandchildren. The funeral was held on Monday afternoon at two o'clock from his late home in Farmingon, conducted by the Rev. E. [Edwin] P. Wood, pastor of the Universalist church of this village, and interment was in the South Farmington cemetery.
