R. H. PFORR DIES AFTER OPERATION

Reinhardt H. Pforr, vice president and purchasing agent of the National Biscuit Company, who lived at 994 Ocean ave., died this morning at the Carson C. Peck Memorial Hospital, following an operation performed there 10 days ago. His family was at his bedside when death came. He leaves a wife and three married daughters, Mrs. George Freeman, Mrs. Frank Bosworth Jr. and Mrs. Charles Mills.

He was several times a delegate to the Republican National Convention and was a member of the 26th Ward Republican Club.

In 1920, he was designated as one of the Hiram Johnson group of delegates to run in the 9th Congressional District, but filed a declination with the Board of Elections. Mr. Pforr was a close friend of Port Appraiser F. J. H. Kracke. He was a member of the board of trustees of All Souls Universalist Church.
