Death of Clark David Phelps

Clark David Phelps, 86 years of age and one of the oldest and most highly respected citizens of the town of Sennett, died suddenly yesterday afternoon at the family home. Mr. Phelps had been in poor health for some time and his sudden death was due to senility and complications. Mr. Phelps had lived in Sennett all his life and was well known through that section. His death will be mourned by a wide acquaintance. He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. [Louise] Selover of Owasco, Mrs. Stella Conklin of this city and Miss [Grace] Phelps of Sennett, and by one son, Clayton A. Phelps of Sennett. Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the family home with Rev. H. [Henry] M. Cary, pastor of the First Universalist Church, officiating. Interment will be made in Sennett Rural Cemetery.
