Pickard Dies of Heart Attack

FORT PLAIN, Feb. 25.—Ralph H. Pickard, 57, died early this morning at Amsterdam City hospital of heart trouble.

He was born July 8, 1879, in the Town of Minden, son of Martin A. and Mary M. Dillenbeck Pickard, and has resided in this section all his life. He conducted a store in the Town of Rex for the past 40 years and has been justice of the peace for 20 years. He was a member of the Universalist church of this village; also a member of the town board of Fort Plain.

He is survived by his wife [Elmina]; one daughter, Mrs. Harold [Ruth] Cronkhite and one grandson, Roger Cronkhite, both of Hallsville.

The funeral will be held from the home in Rex Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. Gustav H. Ulrich, pastor of the Universalist church of this village, officiating. Burial will be in the Fort Plain cemetery.
