GEORGE PIERCE DIES SUDDENLY
Found in Room, Believed Victim of Heart Disease

Little Falls, Sept. 11—George Pierce, 54, formerly a resident of Schenectady, but who had resided here for the past year with his sister-in-law, Mrs. Nora Pierce, at 325 South William Street, died suddenly this afternoon at her home. He had been in his room and was found dead shortly after noon today. His death was due to heart disease with which he had been afflicted for some time.

The deceased was born in Johnstown, a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Frank Pierce. He lived for 20 years in Johnstown and then came here for a time and then went to Schenectady where he lived until coming here.

He leaves one brother, Eugene Pierce, California. He also leaves three nephews and three nieces.

The funeral will be held Tuesday morning at 11 a.m. from the home in South William Street, Rev. Trueman J. Menadue [Universalist] officiating. Burial will be made in the family plot at Fairview Cemetery, Schenectady.
