GEORGE PRAIM IS TAKEN BY DEATH  
Funeral of Dolgeville Man Will be Today at 1:30

DOLGEVILLE, N.Y.—George Praim passed away at his home early Sunday morning from a complication of diseases following ill health for several months.

He was born July 19, 1869, near Stratford. His parents were the late Alexander and Ruby Leavitt Praim. He was married in September, 1895 to Carrie Bullock, who is the only survivor. He came to Dolgeville in 1904 where he was in partnership with Mr. Bullock in the feed business under the firm name of Praim and Bullock. In 1924 they sold out and he ran a general store in Dolgeville until 1931 when he retired. He and his wife have spent the last five winters in St. Petersburg, Florida. Mr. Priam was a member of the Masonic Lodge and the Universalist church.

The funeral will be held from the late home on Helmer avenue at 1:30 this afternoon and Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton will officiate, assisted by Rev. Leslie A. Potter. Burial will be made in the Dolgeville cemetery. Friends are requested to omit flowers.
