Mrs. Julia Pratt

Herkimer—Mrs. Julia H. Pratt, 80, died yesterday afternoon at the her daughter Miss Isabelle Fitch in Park Avenue.

Death was the result of complications. Mrs. Pratt has been ill since May 1.

The deceased was born at New Berlin Mar. (10?), 1850, but with the exception of seven years' residence in this village practically all of her life was spent in Burlington Flatts and Schuyler Lake.

Mrs. Pratt was twice married, her first husband being Henry Fitch, who died in (1873?).

Her second husband was George Pratt who preceded her in death 19 years ago.

The surviving relatives are three daughters: Miss Isabelle Fitch, of this village, Mrs. J. Gardner of Cooperstown and Mrs. George Herkimer of Schuyler Lake.

Mrs. Pratt was a member of the Universalist Church at Schuyler Lake.

A prayer will be held at her late home at 1 p.m. tomorrow after which the remains will be taken to Schuyler Lake where the funeral will be held at 3 p.m. from the Universalist Church in that village.

The Rev. Lewis H. Robinson of Albion, a life long friend of Mrs. Pratt, will officiate and burial will be in the Schuyler Lake Cemetery.
