OBITUARY.

The death of Joseph W. Prentiss, 71 years old, and a printer for more than half a century, occurred last night after a long illness at his home, 371 Eighth Street. Mr. Prentiss was born at Hudson, where he conducted a printing establishment for many years. He was employed at Albany for several years and then came to Troy, where he was engaged as proofreader on the Troy Record, which position he has held for the last 20 years. Mr. Prentiss was a member of the Universalist Church, the Masonic Lodge at Hudson, the Modern Woodmen of America at Hudson, and the International Typographical Union. The survivors are his wife, who was formerly Alice J. Roosa, and three daughters, the Misses Winifred and Evelyn Prentiss and Mrs. Robert Jackson, all of this city.
