ANDREW JACKSON PROSSER

The death of Andrew Jackson Prosser occurred at his late home near New Berlin on Friday morning, Jan. 29, 1932. He had been in poor health for a number of years and was confined to the bed for a period of three months and was tenderly cared for by his son [Juan] and wife who will sadly miss him.

He was born in Lewis county, N.Y., October 31, 1854, the son of Samuel and Mary Jones Prosser. He was twice married. He married Lavisia Ames of Richfield, Nov. 25, 1884. She died Nov. 18, 1888 and on Oct. 27, 1891 he married Esther Pope of Pittsfield, N.Y. She died Oct. 26, 1929. To this union the one son, Juan was born who has always resided at home. Not only to the family does his death bring sorrow but [to] all who knew him.

Surviving besides the one son mentioned are three grandchildren; three sisters, Mrs. J. B. Lamphere and Mrs. J. B. Case both of Nineveh, N.Y., and Mrs. Alice Sweet of Johnson City. A brother died a number of years ago. Four nieces and two nephews also survive.

The funeral was held at his late home on Monday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock, Rev. F. [Frederick] G. Leonard [Universalist] of Morris officiating. Interment was made in the Hillington cemetery at Morris beside his second wife.
