JENNIE A. QUACKENBUSH

Mrs. Jennie Alger Quackenbush died Saturday at her home in Toddsville, after twenty-seven years of invalidism.

Born March 1, 1863 in Fly Creek, her parents were Eugene and Ellen (Rexford) Alger. All of her life had been lived in the vicinity, the last fifty years having been spent in the same house in which her death occurred. She was married in 1876 to Albert Quackenbush, who died May 6, 1922.

Surviving are a son, Earl Quackenbush of Binghamton; a daughter, Mrs. R. J. Omerzu of Toddsville; eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

She attended the [former] Universalist church, Fly Creek.

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at Ingalls' Funeral Home in Cooperstown, the Rev. F. W. Connell, Methodist pastor, officiating. Interment will be made at Hartwick Seminary.
