ROBERT RAMSHAW

The death of Robert Ramshaw occurred at his home north of Ridgeway Saturday morning at seven-thirty, aged 81 years. He was a veteran of the Civil War and a member of the G.A.R. Hood Post No. 91, of Medina. He enlisted November 6, 1861 at Hartland, mustered in as private of Co. E, 8th New York Cavalry, and was discharged for disability October 10, 1863, at Camp Virginia. He re-enlisted May 23, 1864 and was discharged September 21, 1865 at Camp Barry, D.C.

He served as constable of the town of Ridgeway for about 45 years.

He is survived by his wife, two daughters, Mrs. F.K. Dunham of East Bloomfield, N.Y., Mrs. Albone of Ridgeway; one granddaughter, Melsa Ramshaw; a grandson, Harold Albone and four great grandchildren.

The funeral was in charge of G.A.R. and was held from his late home Tuesday at two o'clock, the Rev. C. C. [Charles Clare] Blauvelt of Middleport Universalist church officiating. Burial in West Ridgeway.
