RANSOM—At his home in Canastota, Oct. 13th, 1898, of catarrhal-pneumonia, George S. Ransom, aged 73 years. Mr. Ransom was born March 4th, 1825 on the farm now owned and occupied by Nathaniel Brockett, in the town of Manheim. In Feb., 1846 he married Amanda Hoover, daughter of Jacob and Polly Hoover, of the same town, and they lived at the homestead where he was born until 1858, where the remaining years of his life were spent. For the past 29 years Mr. Ransom has been a resident of Canastota. He always enjoyed the confidence and respect of all with whom he came in contact, either in a business or social relation, and by those who knew and loved him best, his memory will ever be held dear. His funeral was held last Saturday at 3 p.m. at his late residence, Rev. V. [Vincent] E. Tomlinson [Universalist] of Little Falls officiating, assisted by the pastor of the Presbyterian church of Canastota.

The remains were taken to Ingham's Mills Sunday morning for interment. The deceased is survived by his widow.
