MRS. JEANNETTE RANSOM PASSES AT DOLGEVILLE;
HAD BEEN ILL SIX YEARS

Dolgeville, Oct. 10—Mrs. Jeannette Ransom died Tuesday in the home of her nephew, Dr. W. H. Petrie on N. Main street, after an illness of six years. During four years of that time she had been unable to leave her bed. The cause of death was paralysis.

The deceased was born on the Salisbury road in the Town of Manheim 73 years ago and was the daughter of Charles Arnold, who was a well-known contractor in that locality. Forty-five years ago she was married to Sidney G. Ransom, who was an undertaker here for many years and whose death occurred in 1906. Mrs. Ransom was a member of the Universalist Church and was a very fine woman who was loved by a wide circle of friends. She was the last surviving member of her family.

The funeral will be held from the home of Dr. Petrie at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon, the Rev. C. A. Moulton of the Universalist Church officiating. Interment will be made in the Dolgeville Cemetery.
