PAUL C. RANSOM DEAD IN FLORIDA FORMER WELL-KNOWN LAWYER AND CLUBMAN OF BUFFALO PASSES AWAY

Paul Carlton Ransom, formerly a well-known lawyer of this city, is dead at Cocoanut Grove, Fla., to which place he went some time ago for his health. News to that effect was received here yesterday.

Mr. Ransom was born at Earlville, N.Y., in 1863, and was graduated from Williams College in 1886. After his graduation he took up the study of law at Harvard Law School and Columbia Law School. After reading law in New York City for some time he was admitted to the bar, entering into partnership with J. Carrington Avery of this city.

In 1903 he married Alice Ruth Carter, daughter of a former president of Williams College. Mr. Ransom was a member of the Saturn, Buffalo and Country clubs and at one time was manager of the Fresh Air Mission. He was also a trustee of the First Universalist Church and a member of the Kappa Alpha Fraternity at Williams, the Hasty Pudding Society at Harvard and the University Club in New York.

The deceased was a brother of Frank H. and Charles M. Ransom of the firm of D. Ransom, Son & Co., and of Mrs. Arthur Milinowski, whose husband is the treasurer of the company.
