Herman Lipe Rebell, 64, died at the Veterans Hospital, Los Angeles, Calif., Tuesday morning, following an illness of several days.

Born in Fort Plain March 30, 1891, the son of the late Henry Rebell and Clara Lipe Rebell, he moved to the Pacific coast a number of years ago.

A former commander of Fort Plain Post No. 554, American Legion, Mr. Rebell was one of the World War I Legionnaires who made possible the acquisition of the former Rialto theater property during the 1930s and its subsequent conversion into a post home.

He was also a member of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain.
