Natural Bridge, April 3.—The death of George Reed occurred Sunday at the home of his brother, James Reed, in Mill street.

He had been employed in the paper mill at Carthage for several years. He had been a great sufferer from Bright's disease for the past three years, being able to work only part of the time. He came back to his old home about two months ago, gradually failing until the end came. He was born in this place in 1854, being one of ten children of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Allen Reed. He had spent nearly his whole life in the town of Wilna.

He was unmarried. He is survived by his aged mother, Mrs. Ann Reed, and three brothers, Charles of Sioux Falls, S.D., William of Williamsport, Pa., and James of this place.

His funeral was held today at 2 p.m. from his late home, Rev. C. [Clarence] J. Cowing [Universalist] of Canton officiating.
