YOUTH'S RITES ON SATURDAY

The funeral for Albert A. Reudink, 19, son of Mr. and Mrs. Engbert A. Reudink, 267 Pratt Street, who died the Mercy hospital emergency room at 8:30 Thursday morning, seven hours after an automobile accident, will be at 11 Saturday morning at the Cleveland-McCallen funeral home.

Rev. Blaine F. Hartford, pastor of the All Souls Universalist church, will officiate. Burial will be in Brookside cemetery.

Friends may call at the funeral home this afternoon from 2 to 4 today and 7 to 9 tonight.

Mr. Reudink, a student at the Jefferson Community college, was fatally injured when the car he was driving struck a house at the corner of Route 12, Watertown-Copenhagen road, and Churchill road, Tylerville, after the car failed to make a right curve. The car struck three mailboxes, crossed a lawn and crashed into the home of Mrs. Mildred Varney, Churchill Road.
