MRS. E. A. REVERE DIES; KIN OF SAMUEL ADAMS

Mrs. Edith Atherton Revere, widow of George O. Revere, who was a direct descendant of Paul Revere, died yesterday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alice Packard Palmer, 130 E. 19th st., after a protracted illness. She was born in Massachusetts 71 years ago and was a direct descendant of Samuel Adams and Sir Humphrey Atherton. With her husband, Mrs. Revere was an active member for many years of the Universalist Church of the Good Tidings [Fourth Universalist], and the pastor, the Rev. E. H. Lalone, will officiate at the services in the Fairchild Chapel, 86 Lefferts pl., tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock. Interment will be private in Evergreens Cemetery. Mrs. Revere is survived by her daughter, Mrs. Palmer; two grandchildren, Miss Ruth A. Palmer and Edward A. Palmer, and two stepsons, Paul and Herbert Revere.
