Ex-Madison Mayor Dies

MADISON—Herman H. Reynolds, 69, former mayor of this village and prominent business man in this area, died Friday in St. Elizabeth's Hospital, Utica.

A native of Franklin Springs, he was born Feb. 15, 1897, the son of Seymour and Alice Wentworth Reynolds. He moved to Madison with his family in 1898.

Mr. Reynolds was educated in Madison schools and married the former Miss Lenore Eastman in Barre, Vt., in 1928.

He and his father established the S. J. Reynolds & Son Dodge Agency in this village in 1916. It was considered one of the oldest Dodge agencies in the nation.

Mr. Reynolds was a former member of the Knights of Pythias, a member of the Alliance Lodge F&AM, of Oriskany Falls, the Elks Lodge of Oneida, the Yahundasis Golf and Country Club of Utica, Seven Oaks Club of Hamilton, and the Colgate Maroon Council.

He was also a former member of the board of Community Memorial Hospital in Hamilton.

Mr. Reynolds served as Mayor of Madison in the early 1950's. He was a member of the Madison Universalist Church.

Surviving besides his wife, are a sister, Mrs. Basil Ames, Madison, and three nieces.
