Death of Mrs. Rhodes

After an illness of about five months, Mrs. Caroline M. Rhodes died at the home of her sister, Mrs. D. B. Harrigan, on West Main street, Thursday afternoon, August 22. The funeral services were held at the residence, Friday afternoon, the Rev. E. A .[Alice] Bradley [Universalist] officiating.
