GEORGE RICER OF FORT PLAIN EXPIRES AT 89

FORT PLAIN, March 27—George Ricer, 89, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. William A. Beitchman, Beck Street, early Monday morning after a brief illness.

Mr. Ricer was born at Jacksonburg, Herkimer County, February 20, 1862, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Michael Ricer. His wife, Maude Schuyler Ricer, died in 1937.

He conducted a farm at one time near Little Falls and in later years with his son, Glenn, operated the GLF feed store in Little Falls. Retiring in 1941, Mr. Ricer sold the feed business to his son.

He attended the Universalist Church and was a charter member of the Snell's Bush Grange.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Beitchman, with whom [he] resided, and Mrs. George Hessler, Rochester; two sons, Floyd S. Ricer, St. Petersburg, Fla., and Glenn B. Ricer, Town of Manheim, Little Falls; two granddaughters, Evelyn R. Hessler and Adeline Hessler, Rochester, several nieces and nephews.

The Rev. Lyman Achenbach, pastor of the Universalist Church of the Messiah, Fort Plain, will conduct funeral services at the Swartz funeral home, Center Street, Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Interment will be made in Inghams Mills Cemetery.
