MRS. GEORGE RICER, LITTLE FALLS, DIES

LITTLE FALLS—Maude Evelyn Schuyler Ricer died suddenly of a stroke at her home on Top Notch Road last evening, Mar. 2, 1937.

She was born in Oppenheim in November, 1874, daughter of the late Smith and Alvina Darling Schuyler. She was married to George Ricer Dec. (13?), 1894 and came to Little Falls to live. Prior to that time she had lived in the Twin Cities section.

Mrs. Ricer was a member of the Shells Bush Grange and the Universalist Church.
