ANN ELIZA RICHARDSON

Mrs. Ann Eliza Richardson, widow of the late Rev. C. [Chester] C. Richardson passed away at her home on Buffalo street, August 1, 1927. Mrs. Richardson was born at Yonker[s], N.Y., January 13, 1824, the daughter of the late M. Anthony and Harriet C. Rabell of old Revolutionary ancestry. Her family consisted of five children. The late Mrs. Hattie E. Evans of Warsaw, Mrs. C. [Charles] L. Arnold of Detroit, the late Dr. W. [William] E. Richardson of Batavia, Dr. E.C. Richardson of East Pembroke, Dr. C.G. Richardson of Varysburg. Mrs. Richardson is also survived by nine grandchildren, six great grandchildren and one brother, M.A. Rabell of Meadville, Pa. Mrs. Richardson had been a resident of Warsaw for over 40 years. Her husband the late Rev. C.C. Richardson was one of the pioneer clergy of the Universalist church of Western New York.

The funeral which will be private will be held at the home this (Thursday) afternoon. She will be buried in Warsaw cemetery.
