Sudden Death

D. C. Richardson, a man well known in this vicinity, died suddenly of heart trouble at the Grand Central Hotel at Genesee, Friday morning. He was sick some time ago but had so far recovered that all supposed he had regained his usual health.

He was formerly a resident of this place but for the past 20 years had lived most of the time in Wellsville.

Mr. Richardson was an exceptionally good violinist and furnished music for parties extensively, but worked at painting and paper hanging much of the time. He came to Genesee a few months ago intending to remain during the winter.

[On] Saturday afternoon the remains were brought to the home of his brother, C. C. Richardson of this place, and funeral services, conducted by Rev. H. J. Orelup of the Universalist church, were held from the house Monday afternoon.
