MRS. FRED RICHARDSON

Mrs. Fred Richardson, 69, who has been in failing health during the past two years, died on the 14th at her home in Perry Center.

The deceased was the eldest of five children of James and Lucy Barber Shaw and was born in Arcade on Nov. 15, 1866, her parents removing to Perry from Java about 45 years ago.

On Nov. 15, 1893, she was united in marriage to Fred Richardson of Perry, going to Brockport, where they remained five years, then removing to Perry and remaining three years, then going to the old Richardson homestead in Gibsonville, where they resided during a period of 11 years. They then removed to the farm at Perry Center which has since been their home.

Mrs. Richardson was a woman of pleasing personality and a kind neighbor who was ever ready to help when needed. She was esteemed by all who knew her and who deeply sympathize with the bereaved family.

She has been in poor health during the past two years and gradually failed until Thanksgiving time, when she was obliged to take to her bed and unable to leave it since.

During the last few weeks she has failed to recognize anyone, gradually growing weaker until about noon on January 14th, when she passed to the Great Beyond where her sufferings are over and her spirit is at rest.

Besides her husband she is survived by two brothers, two sisters, a son and a granddaughter, viz: Guy and Lloyd [Shaw] and Mrs. John Harding of Perry; and Mrs. Fred C. Bliss of Denver, Col.; Don and Dona Lea of Perry.

She was affiliated with the Universalist Church parish of Perry. Funeral services will be held this (Thursday) afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the family residence at Perry Center. Rev. L. R. Lowry will officiate, with interment in Glenwood Cemetery in Perry.
