Feb. 25.—Alonzo T. Richey, who for twenty-five years was station agent here, died at his home Wednesday morning, after a lingering illness of Bright's disease. Mr. Richey was born in Belmont [sic], N.Y., 72 years ago, but for many years has been highly respected resident of Winthrop. He is survived by one son, John C. Richey, of New York city. His funeral was largely attended from the Universalist Church Friday, Rev. F. Line, assisted by Rev. H. V. Searls, officiating. The service at the grave was conducted by the Masonic fraternity representing Constellation Lodge, F. & A. M., of Malone, of which he was a member. A delegation from Brasher Falls Lodge was also present. Mr. Richey will be missed as a kind neighbor and friend, ever noted for his surpassing characteristics of generosity and sympathy.
