Unconscious for the week previous to her demise, at the Sanitarium in Castile, N. Y., where she was being cared for, Miss Inez M. Richmond, daughter of the late George W. and Ella Ketcham Richardson, passed away peacefully on Monday, Nov. 19, 1928. She had suffered a general breakdown early this year thought to have resulted from overwork as a practical nurse. She suffered an attack of influenza early last spring which had weakened her system.

Deceased was 56 years of age. She was born at Cameron, N.Y., but most of her life was spent in Whitesville. She was a member of the Universalist church, Ladies' Aid, and Whitesville Rebekah Lodge.

Surviving are her brother Frank Richmond and a number of nephews and nieces.

The funeral was held from the late home, Wednesday afternoon, Nov. 21, 1928 at 2 o'clock.

Rev. [R. S.] Kellerman, assisted by Rev. Eagler, officiating [sic] and burial was in Rural Cemetery.
