HE DIED SUDDENLY

Murray W. Richmond, a Genesee Man Well Known Here, Passes Away

People here were shocked and surprised, Monday, to learn that Murray W. Richmond of Genesee had expired. He had been ill for a number of days but was improving rapidly and THE NEWS of last week contained an item to that effect. Monday, he was suddenly stricken with heart disease and the end came quickly.

Mr. Richmond was born April 23, 1866, and was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Harvey Richmond, both now deceased. Miss Jennie Harris became his wife in 1884, and until a few years ago they resided on South Hill, moving from there to Genesee where he engaged in the mercantile business.

That he was a man of good qualities was shown by the large attendance at the funeral held from the Universalist church, of which he was a member, yesterday afternoon. Rev. James Herrick officiated and interment was made in Rural cemetery.

Surviving him, besides the hosts of friends and distant relatives, are the wife and two children, Lynn and Lela. Also one brother and two sisters, Ortho Richmond, Mrs. Willis Wood, and Mrs. S. J. Hull, all of Wellsville.
