RIDER, LAWYER, FOUND DEAD

Stricken with a heart attack some time during the night, Arthur Burton Rider, 76, a practicing attorney for the last 50 years, was found dead at this home, 104 Fitch st., Thursday morning. He was found a 6 o'clock this morning by his sister, Mrs. Warren H. Blankman, with whom he resided.

Born in Mexico [NY], Mr. Rider attended the Mexico Academy and was graduated from the old Hamilton College Law School at Hamilton more than half a century ago.

Following his graduation he practiced in Pennsylvania and Cattaraugus County for four years and then came to Syracuse.

He was associated with the late Welcome Betts in the practice of law here under the firm name of Rider & Betts for a number of years and for the last year maintained offices in the Everson building with W. D. Cheney.

Mr. Rider was a member of the Onondaga County Bar Association, the Citizens Club and the Sons of the American Revolution. He was also a member of Betts Memorial Universalist Church. Besides the sister he is survived by five nephews and a niece.

The funeral will take place at the home at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Burial will be in Onondaga Hill cemetery.
